
DEVELOPING AND ENHANCING THE PRACTICE AND MANAGEMENT OF SCHOLARLY ACTIVITY AND RESEARCH WITHIN FURTHER EDUCATION COLLEGES

The Higher Education Academy will be running three, one-day events to support practitioners to engage with scholarly activity/research and to allow managers to receive information in regard to successfully managing it within a further education college (FEC) setting. Key issues to be covered at these events are as follows:

- i. The meaning of scholarly activity and research
- ii. The key aspects of the research process including research design/ dissemination
- iii. Making funding applications
- iv. Managing a research project
- v. Key resources to support their engagement with scholarly activity
- vi. Considerations for and management of scholarly activity/ research within an FEC
- vii. Institutional impacts from scholarly activity/research

The first event will be held at Stockport College on 4 December 2009. Two further events are planned, one in the Midlands (to be held on 25 March 2010 at the Higher Education Academy Engineering Subject Centre) and one in the South of England (between the 7–18 June 2010).
